COVID-19 HAS CREATED HAVOC IN MANY LIVES

- 13 Life support ventilators installed in COVID 19 designated hospitals
- 30 ICU beds, 21,619 PPE kits, 20,000 3-ply masks, 26,780 N95 masks, 38,844 disposable bed sheets, 3,00,000 hand gloves materials donated to 7 Government Hospitals for supporting the front line healthcare workers
- 3,500+ masks and 16,000 individual sanitizer bottles distributed among Anganwadi workers in Telangana
- Livelihood support provided to 150+ women through mask making production. 2,50,000+ masks produced till date

During the unprecedented COVID-19 times, education to the under-previleged students is a challenge since they do not have access to digital devices such as smart phones.

- To promote Digital Online Learning, we are providing Tablets and internet access to high school students so they could access the online classes and resources required for their learning.
- In the process of supporting 1365 students with tablets across Telangana and Karnataka. We aim to expand this support to further students in these states along with those in Andhra Pradesh.
